

# McKay Landing Pool Rules

1. Swim at your own risk when no lifeguard is on duty.
2. The gate is to remain locked at all times – you must have your key fob with you. Fence jumping will result in loss of pool privileges.
3. Small children and all other persons who are unable to swim must be supervised by a responsible adult who can swim.
4. The pool and facilities are for the sole use of the McKay Landing residents and a resident must accompany all guests.
5. Up to four (4) guests per household.
6. No smoking or vaping is allowed within the pool and the pool area.
7. No glass containers or alcohol is permitted in the pool area.
8. Pets are not allowed in the pool area and may not be chained to the fence.
9. No loud noise or music is permitted.
10. No running, jumping, pushing, shoving, dunking or rough housing.
11. No offensive behavior is permitted; including, but not limited to cursing, creating disturbances, and inappropriate language/conversations.
12. Bikes, skateboards, scooters and rollerblades must be left outside the pool area.
13. Swim diapers with plastic pants must be worn by all incontinent individuals.
14. The use of small flotation devices or pool toys is permitted; lifeguards have full discretion regarding the size of acceptable pool toys and floats.
15. Failure to comply with these rules will result in the loss of pool privileges.
16. Failure to follow the instructions of the pool monitor can result in both the loss of pool privileges and the police being called.
17. No diving permitted at any time.
